FALL 2018 Refund Policy

If a student drops a class before the official first day of classes or during the add/drop period and is still registered for other classes in the semester, a full refund is due for the class dropped. If a student drops a class after the add/drop period, no refund is due.

The add/drop period for Fall and Fall Mini I is **August 20 – August 22**. The add/drop period for Fall Mini II is **October 11** and **October 12**.

If a student withdraws from <u>all</u> Fall or Fall Mini I classes **before August 20**, a 100% refund of tuition will be processed.

If a student is registered for Fall Mini II classes <u>only</u>, the student would need to withdraw **before October 11** in order to receive a 100% refund of tuition.

Officially withdrawing from all classes before the official first day of classes will entitle the student to a 100% refund. Percentage refund processed for complete withdrawal during below dates:
