**SUMMER 2018  
REFUND POLICY**

If a student drops a class before the official first day of classes or during the add/drop period and is still registered for other classes in the semester, a full refund is due for the class dropped. If a student drops a class after the add/drop period, no refund is due.

The add/drop period for Summer Mini I is **May 9 – May 10**.

The add/drop period for Full Summer and Summer Mini II is **May 30 – May 31**.

The add/drop period for Summer Mini III is **July 5 – July 6**.

If a student withdraws from all Summer I classes **before May 9**, a 100% refund of tuition will be processed.

If a student is registered for Summer III classes only, the student would need to withdraw **before July 5** in order to receive a 100% refund of tuition.

Officially withdrawing from all classes before the official first day of classes will entitle the student to a 100% refund. Percentage refund processed for complete withdrawal during the below dates:
