

MATH HELP

There are many resources available to help you. Below is a list of some of these. You can also contact the Math Division in Naylor Hall, (256) 549-8322, for more information.

- **Math Lab Tutoring** – Tutoring is available through the Math Division in the math labs, Naylor 206 & 207. Hours are posted throughout the Division and on the door at Naylor 206. Call (256) 549-8309 for more information.
- **SMARTHINKING** – This is a 24 hour tutoring service. Log in to Blackboard. Click on the “**SMARTHINKING**” link located in the Tools section. Each GSCC student has 180 minutes of free tutoring available. For more information, contact Janekia Mitchell at (256) 549-8212 or jmitchell@gadsdenstate.edu.
- **Textbook Software** – Online software is available with many math textbooks. This software typically includes practice problems, online help with problems, videos, eText, and more. An example is MyMathLab for MTH 090, 098, 100, 112, & 113. The textbook software may have additional costs associated if you did not receive an access code with your text. Contact your instructor for more information.
- **Student Support Services** – Student Support Services offers free one-on-one tutoring and other benefits for qualifying students. Call (256) 549-8375 for more information about Student Support Services on the Gadsden Campus or (256) 835-5465 for Student Support Services on the Ayers Campus.
- **Veterans Upward Bound** – Veterans Upward Bound (VUB) offers tutoring and other benefits for qualifying students, including veterans and adult students. Call (256) 549-8204 for more information about VUB on the Gadsden Campus or (256) 238-9354 for VUB at the McClellan Center or (256) 835-5481 for VUB at the Ayers Campus.
- **GSCC Library** – All GSCC library locations house resources such as DVDs and texts to help with specific courses and topics. Call (256) 549-8333 for more information about library resources on the Gadsden Campus.
- **Blackboard** – If your course has a Blackboard component or comparable course learning management system available, you should explore that course content. Many instructors have PowerPoints, videos, and/or other resources available.
- **External Tutoring** – A list of external tutors is available in the Naylor Hall Math Lab, room 206.
- **Your Instructor/Advisor** – Remember that you can always contact your instructor or advisor to make an appointment to meet with him/her for help and advice during office hours. Office hours are generally posted on office doors. You may also email specific questions.
