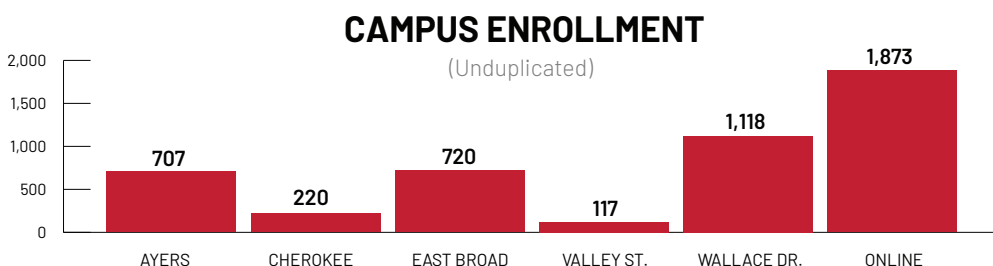

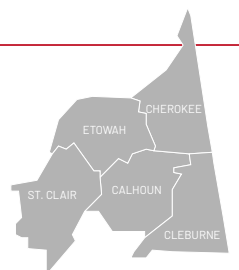

COUNTIES IN GSCC SERVICE AREA

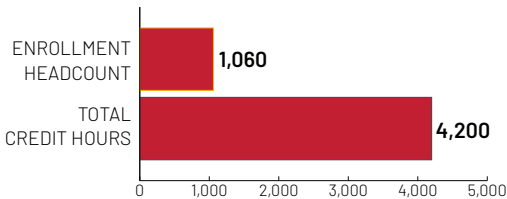

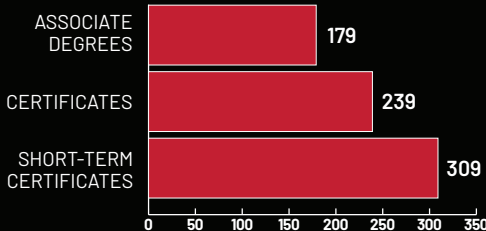

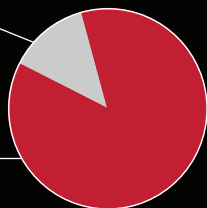
