Admission Requirements:

- Unconditional admission to the College
- Submission of Program's online application by midnight July 1 of the year of admission
- Submission of the following documents to the Admissions & Records Office by midnight July 1 of the year of admission:
 - All transcripts (official high school and college) or official GED scores
 - Official ACT scores with minimum composite score of 18
- Applicants must be at least 18 years of age.
- A minimum 2.50 GPA for required Medical Laboratory Technology general education courses (if multiple attempts, the highest grade will be used for determination)
- A minimum 2.50 high school GPA (for students without prior college work)
- Applicants must be eligible for placement into the following courses: MTH 100
- Applicants must be in good standing with the College
- Applicants must meet the **Essential Functions** required for Medical Technology students.

Essential Functions are the fundamental job duties and skills associated with a particular position. All students are required to read the Essential Functions identified for Medical Laboratory Technology and determine if they are capable of performing these functions with or without reasonable accommodation. Students must be able to:

- ✓ Lift 40 pounds
- ✓ Hear high and low frequency sounds within normal range with or without corrective devices
- ✓ See with 20-40 visual acuity with or without corrective lenses
- ✓ Feel veins and pulses
- ✓ Smell body and environmental odors
- ✓ Coordinate eye and hand movements
- ✓ Coordinate motor movements
- ✓ See different color spectrums
- ✓ Read, comprehend and write legibly in the English language
- ✓ Send and receive verbal messages in the English language and be able to respond appropriately
- ✓ Perform correctly simple mathematical computations
- ✓ Walk and transport equipment without assistance
- ✓ Reach and position overhead equipment used in the laboratory
- ✓ Be oriented to reality and not be mentally impaired by mind-altering substances
